








MONTSERRAT

MNI Networks Ltd.

- MNI Networks Ltd. is an IT company located in Montserrat and operated under the laws of Montserrat.
- MNI Networks Ltd. provides a variety of ICT services and consultancies including; programming, web development, network design, network installation and maintenance.
- Under agreement with the Government of Montserrat, MNI Networks Ltd. is the Sponsor and Administrator for the .MS ccTLD.





- 2000: Found out that the .MS Registry was operated by AdamsNames Ltd., UK since 1997 AdamsNames was unsanctioned and did not contribute any funds or equipment to the Government or any local organisation. (marketing in Mississippi)
- 2001 2006: Investigates how to get the .MS Registry local (no real interest).
 - .AG; .AI; .DM; .GY locally operated. (not comfortable with the big companies) -

How do we get started??

- 2007 Feb: Attended ISOC ccTLD workshop in Guyana.
 - Met ICANN staff Jacob Malthouse and John Crain.
- 2007 May: Entered into an Agreement with the Government of Montserrat to manage the .MS domain name.
 - The Government notifies AdamsNames and ICANN of their position.





- 2007 June: Attended 29th ICANN meeting in San Juan (technical)
 - Are we out of our depth?
 - Gained confidence, made useful contacts
- 2007 July: started to work with CoCCA with a view towards using their Registry Management software.
 - (CoCCA offered the autonomy required)
- 2007 Aug: MNINET sets up NameServers and Database Servers in Montserrat. (no turning back now) - Contact with ARIN.
- 2007 Nov: Attended 30th ICANN meeting in Los Angelos (policy)
 - We CAN!!
 - Full of confidence and clearer vision
 - Made IANA contacts





- 2007 Dec: Attempted to contact AdamsNames to negotiate Registry transition. (frustrated, but determined)
- 2008 Jan: Focus on policy development. (lots of research)
- 2008 April: AdamsNames and MNINET signed an MOU for the smooth handover of the .MS Registry operations. (things went smoothly thereafter)
- 2008 May: MNINET filed a Redelegation request with IANA.
 - Supplementary Information to Support the Redelegation of the .MS Domain Name to MNI Networks Ltd.
 - Along with about 10 additional pieces of supporting documentation.
- 2008 May: The wait begins...





- 2008 Aug 28th: ICANN Board approves the Redelegation.
- 2008 Dec: Root Zone changes are finally completed. (took a while but we were in contact with IANA all the time.)
- 2008 Dec 23rd: Success! MNI Networks Ltd. is now the official Sponsor and Manager for .MS.
- 2009 Jan: MNI Networks Ltd. starts operation of the .MS Registry.
 - Powered by CoCCA Tools.
- 2009 March: MNI Networks Ltd. joins ccNSO as the 90th member.





Accomplishments

- Implemented a locally operated domain Registry for .MS
- Created local employment.
- Generated an additional revenue stream for Government.
- MNINET has already started to contribute financially to the local community.
- Proved that small countries can operate a Domain Registry to international standards.





Future Plans

In addition to developing the .MS Registry into a world class domain registry service; MNI Networks Ltd. plans to offer the following services in the future:

- Personalized Email Services
- Integration with Company Registrations
- Web Hosting
- Web Development
- E-Commerce
- Exploration of ENUM Services
- Registry Consultancy Services
